Can you imagine what it's like to be homeless? Are you aware that homelessness is on the rise in DuPage County? Join in our efforts to raise awareness of homelessness and to help fund programs for DuPage County victims of homelessness.

Sleep-in-a-Box is open to all SMMP Quest & Peer teens. To participate, you must raise a minimum of \$50. Bring your own box (and take it home with you!). You might also want to bring a tarp or heavy piece of plastic to cover your box, and newspaper to line the bottom of your box. **NO TENTS ARE ALLOWED!** Bring your sleeping bag & pillow and dress for the weather. No snacks are allowed, but water and juice will be provided throughout the night.



Check-in is at 5 PM in the Parish Center on 10-22. Bring your donation check(s) made payable to St. Margaret Mary.

Dinner will be an off-site activity. We need parents to drive for dinner leaving SMMP around 6 PM on Saturday. We also need parents to chaperone either the midnight to 3 AM shift or the 3 AM to 7 AM shift. If you can help, circle the appropriate section on the permission form.

Sleep-in-a-Box ends on Sunday morning at 7 AM. All participants are welcome to get breakfast at *Hospitality Sunday* in the Parish Center.

Teens who wish to participate, but can't sleep out, **MUST** be picked up by a parent (not a sibling) and prior notice must be provided to Candy Rice.

To participate, fill out the Permission Form and return it to the Youth Ministry Office by Monday, October 17th, at 5 PM.
